

## C.L.A.P. - meeting point in Bulgaria – Day 6



Meeting point of the project CLAP – the international cooperation between the Czech Republic, Bulgaria and Lithuania in order to know each nation's culture and intangible and tangible heritage, continued on October 2015 in Bulgaria. As befriended nations we all for the second time met up in Sofia, a capital of Bulgaria, and began with a week full of activities and experienced events not only in a surrounding of our meeting point.

During this week we did many sightseeing tours throughout Sofia, to Plovdiv – the 2<sup>nd</sup> historical Bulgarian's city – and also to the Seven Rila Lakes, landscape with seven tarns, which are situated on the mountain 2500m high.

The trip was planned on the end of a whole program and I have to say that it made on us as the Czech group really good impression.

In the morning of 23<sup>rd</sup> October we took the bus and drove out under the mountain of near-spreaded Rila Mountains. Within sunny morning we, dressed in as warm clothes as we were able to pack with, took 30-minutes long chairlift to get right to the top of the mountain. We took a long, and between all the stones really challenging, walk as we were forced to climb up during going straight up. We saw a few species of protected plants such as different kinds of lichens and zoophagous flowers and even tried an experiment by salt hydrolysis with a water from one of the local lakes.

Although it was really cold there right on the top, it was amazing and beautiful experience, which most of us will definitely remember for a long time.

This project gives the students many new useful informations from culture to nature, allows to meet interesting people and creat long-lasting relationships, and indirectly forces to improving their skills. I would say this project fills its expectations.
